

ShepNet classrooms are on the first floor of Hinshaw Hall at Friends Homes Guilford. Friends Homes (a retirement community) is located at 925 New Garden Road, north of Friendly Avenue across from Guilford College. (Note: New Garden Road is called College Road south of Friendly Avenue and called Jamestown Road south of I-40)).

Instructions for Parking and finding the ShepNet Classroom are:

- 1. From New Garden Road, turn west on Arcadia Drive (2nd traffic light north of the one on Friendly Avenue). A Guilford College parking lot is on the opposite side of New Garden Road at Arcadia.**
- 2. Go one block on Arcadia and then turn left on Ridgcrest Drive. Pass three houses on your left and enter the driveway to the Friends Homes parking area.**
- 3. Bear to the right on the driveway and continue along the south side of the buildings (woods will be on your right) past all buildings to the two-level parking deck east of the buildings.**
- 4. Park in the lower parking deck if there is space, and then enter the building by the closest door – the ShepNet classrooms are the first rooms on the right. If the lower deck is full, park near the woods to the south or on the upper level of the deck.**
- 5. From the upper level, go down the exterior steps from the parking deck and enter the building at the lower level or enter the building at the upper level and immediately on your left take (rather steep) steps down to level one. If you wish to use an elevator, walk the corridor until you reach an elevator midway on the left-hand side. Take it down to the ground floor, walk back to your right (toward the parking deck).**
- 6. An alternative is to find a space adjacent to the woods on the south side of the deck. If those are full, we have permission to use the parking lot of New Garden Friends Meeting – turn right onto New Garden Road, another right at the first stoplight, park and walk on the gravel drive through the woods to FHG.**
- 7. If you have parked somewhere other than the parking deck, enter the building at the (main) south door to Hinshaw and take the hall on your right to H105.**
- 8. ShepNet participants with handicap tags may use the marked spaces at the front (south) entrance of the Hinshaw building.**
- 9. Ask your instructor how to best leave the campus from your parking space – exits to be used depend on the direction you wish to go on New Garden Road (the “no left turn” sign to the city street should be obeyed (but you can ignore the one-way arrows on the Friends Homes driveway.)**
